Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number *1 of 8*.

We had A Wyatt record breaking 125 players front up to the first event of 2016. The players participated in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 44 players, Division 2 had 47 players and Division 3 had 34 players. This was **first** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the [Top Qualified 16 in each division](#) will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the 5th November 2016 at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 *if higher points players are not qualified*.
