Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number *2 of 8*.

We had 86 players participate in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 28 players, Division 2 had 21 players and Division 3 had 29 players. This was **second** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the *Top Qualified 16 in each division* will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the 7th November 2015 at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 *if higher points players are not qualified*.

It was a good turn to the 2nd event of the year in the Wyatt Lower Grade Singles, with 78 starters a great way to continue in 2015.

We had 17 x 180's thrown today by 13 individuals and 12 x 100 plus pegs, the highest being 144 by Greg Sawyer, well done. It was pleasing to see a whole new group of players, 18 participate in the second event of the year. Today we paid out \$880 in the 3 divisions and carried forward \$530 to the end of year Champion of Champions.
