Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number 3 of 8.

We had 95 players front up to the third event of 2017. The players participated in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 36 players, Division 2 had 34 players and Division 3 had 25 players. This was **third** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the **Top Qualified 16 in each division** will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the 14th October 2017 (TBC) at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 **if higher points players are not qualified**.
