Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number *5 of 8*.

We had a 68 players participate in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 21 players, Division 2 had 22 players and Division 3 had 25 players. A total of 4 new players tried the event today. This was **Fifth** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the *Top Qualified 16 in each division* will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the 28th November 2015 at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 *if higher points players are not qualified.*
