Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number 7 of 8.

We had a 71 players participate in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 19 players, Division 2 had 24 players and Division 3 had 28 players. A total of 3 new players tried the event today. This was **seventh** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the [Top Qualified 16 in each division](#) will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the 21st November 2015 at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 ***if higher points players are not qualified.***

Also, If you are a genuine FIFO worker consideration will be given to qualifying with four events only and having accrued enough points but this will a consideration after employer confirmation of working dates.
