This was **8th** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the **Top Qualified 16 in each division** will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the New date of **28th October 2017** at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

**However**, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 **if higher points players are not qualified**.
