Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number 8 of 8.

We had 74 players play in the 8th and final qualifying event of 2016. The players participated in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 25 players, Division 2 had 30 players and Division 3 had 19 players. Numbers were slightly down but not unexpected for the last event and we still had 3 new players today, welcome to the Wyatt Group. This was the **final** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the **Top Qualified 16 in each division** will play off in the Grand Final on the **New Date 1st October 2016** at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 **if higher points players are not qualified.**
