Hello all and welcome to the wrap up of event number 2 of 8.

We had A Wyatt opening fixture with 100 players front up to the second event of 2017. The players participated in the 3 divisions, Division 1 had 36 players, Division 2 had 35 players and Division 3 had 29 players. This was the **second** event of 8 to complete the preliminaries prior to the finals starting where the Top Qualified 16 in each division will play off in the Grand Final on Saturday the 14th October 2017 (TBC) at the Belmont Sports & Rec.

However, you must have played in at least 6 or 75% of the events to be eligible to play. Remember those who have played at least 6 events and are not in the Top 16 will be elevated into the 16 **if higher points players are not qualified**.
